This completed form must be returned with a check for the \$610 Guest Membership Fee no later than June 1. Your enrollment will not be confirmed until the form and check are received. A full refund will be provided if space is unavailable.

Once your registration has been confirmed, your NYC Guest account will be billed for the total tuition, and must be paid in full prior to the start of your child's class.

JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAM GUEST GUIDELINES:

Mission of the Junior Sailing Guest Program: To provide an opportunity for children of non-members who have a strong interest in sailing to participate in the NYC's Junior Sailing Program.

We are delighted to have your child in our program. We emphasize safety and sailing expertise, and we are confident your child will learn and benefit from being part of the NYC's Junior Sailing Program. As a private club, we have outlined guidelines for our junior sailing guests, which are enumerated below.

- 1) **Junior Sailing Guest:** A "Junior Sailing Guest" is a non-member child who is sponsored by a Nantucket Yacht Club member and who participates in the NYC Junior Sailing Program. A child of a non-member may be a Junior Sailing Guest member for up three years, which period may be extended upon approval of the Membership Committee.
- 2) **Priority:** If a class has room for a Junior Sailing Guest, priority will be given to relatives of members.
- 3) **Drop-Off and Pick-Up:**
 - a. Junior Sailing Guests should be dropped off when their class begins and picked up when their class ends (unless visiting the Snack Bar as per 4b below.)
 - b. Drop off and pick up should take place at the front entrance. After class, parents should wait by the front door for their kids.
 - c. Parking is limited at the Club, and is particularly scarce between 11:30 am and 1:30 pm. The Club cannot extend parking privileges to guest members, except when a parent needs to accompany a hesitant child or speak specifically with their child's sailing instructors. In these cases, we ask that guest parents park their vehicles in the Club lot for no more than twenty minutes.
- 4) **Use of Club:** The following privileges are extended to Junior Sailing Guests:
 - a. Ability to attend sailing classes;
 - b. Permission to use the Snack Bar before and/or after sailing class.

In addition to the privileges above, Junior Sailing Guests may use the Club as a guest when accompanied by a member as specifically described in the current NYC Regulations and House Rules: "A guest may be introduced by a member a total of three times during the season (i.e.: three times by one member or once each by three members.)"

Junior Sailing Guests may not use the Club if not sailing (except using the Snack Bar before and/or after sailing classes) and may not invite non-members to the Club.

- 5) **Audit Numbers:** Audit numbers will be issued to Junior Sailing Guests. Junior Sailing Guests may use the audit numbers for the following purposes only:
 - a. To purchase lunch, snacks and beverages from the Snack Bar before or after sailing class.
 - b. To purchase sailing gear from the sailing room or Front Desk.

Audit numbers issued to Junior Sailing Guests may not be used by other members of the family or friends.

6) **Additional Opportunities:** Junior Sailing Guests are encouraged to participate in Pirate Day and other special sailing opportunities and to attend award presentations together with their families.
